9:30 a.m.– 11:30 a.m. Physick Estate and Trolley Tour

The Mid-Atlantic Center for the Arts (MAC), a multi-faceted nonprofit cultural organization, was founded in 1970 to save the Emlen Physick Estate. MAC is dedicated to preserving and interpreting Victorian Heritage and architecture and promoting the performing arts. The 1879 Emlen Physick Estate of Cape May's Victorian showplace with 15 rooms authentically restored to their original grandeur. Changing seasonal exhibits provide a glimpse of daily life in a Victorian household.

The second part of this tour is a narrated trolley tour of Cap May's Historic District. Half the group will tour the Physick Estate while the other half Trolleys through the Historic District.

11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Guided Tour/Cape May State Park & Lighthouse and a visit to Sunset Beach to hunt for Cap May "diamonds" on the beach.

Cape May Point State Park is located on the historic Cape May Peninsula at the southern tip of New Jersey! The park is home to the Cape May Point Lighthouse, a 157-foot tall structure that is still commissioned as an aid to navigation! The oil shed adjacent to the lighthouse has been converted into a small welcome center and gift shop.

1:15 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. Lunch on own and shopping time at the Washington Mall area

Group will be dropped off at the Welcome Center so that you may walk The Washington Mall area. This is not a mall, but a small three block area closed to traffic with little quaint shops and eateries. A must see while in Cape May!

If thee are passengers who don't wish to stay here but would rather return to the hotel, it is not a problem. The driver has to return to the hotel to park the coach. If some want to stay and have lunch and then return, it's only a short three- to four-block easy walk back to the hotel.
